1. GMI Readiness Framework

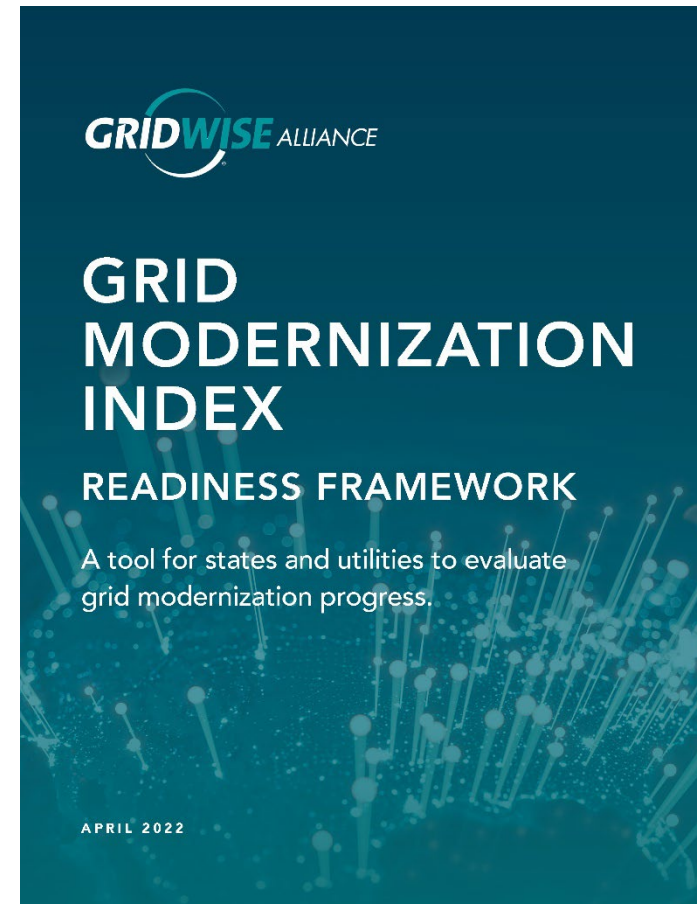

2. Data Collection and Case Studies

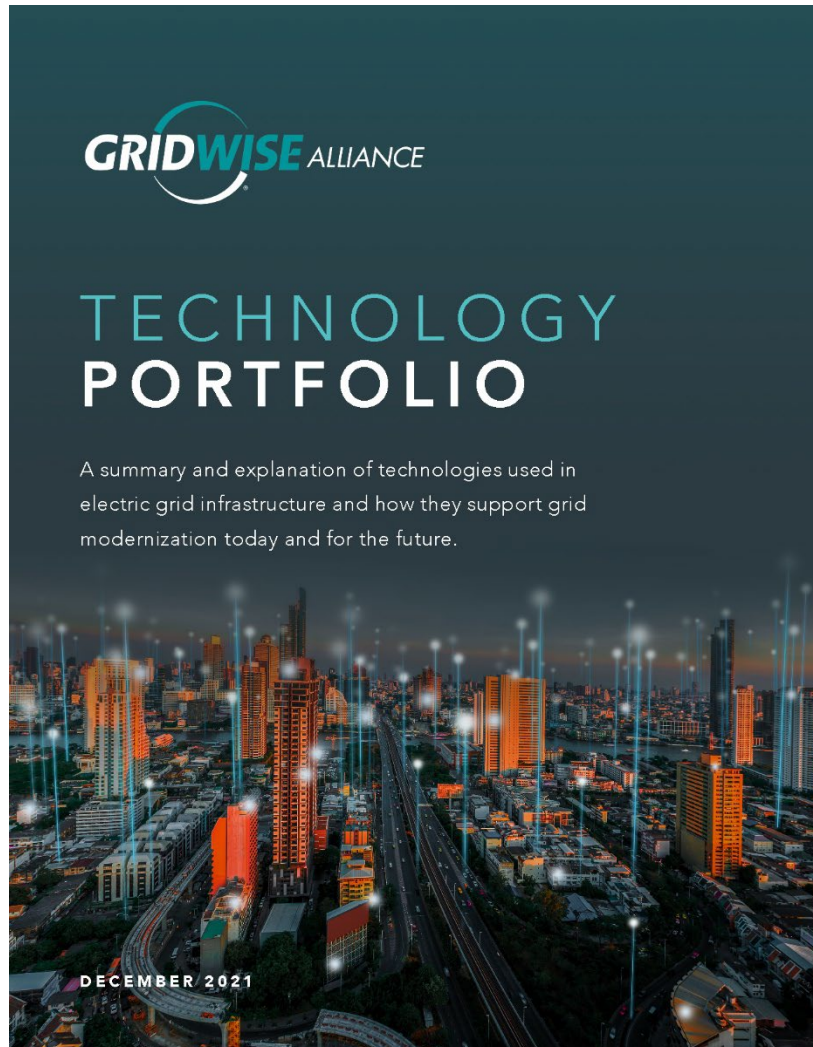

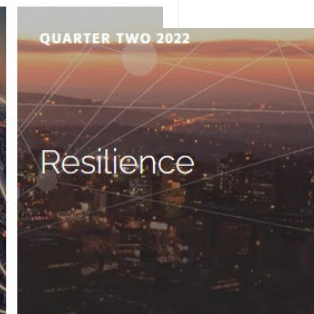
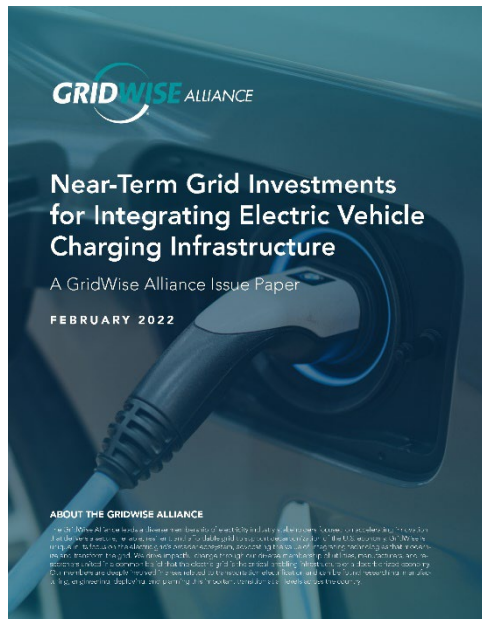
